However, I also recognize it is impossible for the District to restrict access to all controversial and inappropriate materials. I accept full responsibility for supervision if and when my child's use is not in a school setting. I have discussed the terms of the Authorization with my child. I hereby request that my child be allowed access to the Internet.
